

# Network 10

## Australia's Biggest Morning Tea

### Terms and Conditions

1. Information on how to enter forms part of the terms of entry. Entry into the Australia's Biggest Morning Tea Competition ("**Competition**") is deemed acceptance of these terms and conditions.

#### **Eligibility to Enter**

2. Entry is open to all residents of Australia, 18 years and older. However, employees and the immediate families of Network Ten Pty Limited (the "**Promoter**"), Cancer Council (the "**Sponsor**") and their associated agencies and companies or any organisation or individual associated with the provision of the prize are not eligible to enter the Competition. Entrants must be residing in Australia at the time of entry, or their entry may be deemed invalid.
3. Entrants must be registered to be a host in Australia's Biggest Morning Tea on to be eligible to enter.

#### **Competition Period**

4. The competition commences on **Monday, 9 March 2026 at 00:00 AEDT** and closes on **Sunday, 26 April 2026 at 23:59 AEST** ("**Competition Period**").

#### **How to Enter**

6. To participate in the Competition entrants must:
  - a. Log on to [10.com.au/win](http://10.com.au/win) and register their details. Specific details may vary and may include (but not limited to) first name, last name, post code, phone number, email address and month and year of birth, to become a 10 subscriber AND;
  - b. Be registered as a host for Australia's Biggest Morning Tea

Cancer Council’s Privacy Policy may be updated from time to time, and it will be the entrant’s responsibility to keep up to date with any changes to the Privacy Policy. You consent to the Promoter collecting your personal information for the purpose of conducting and promoting this Competition (including but not limited to determining and notifying the Prize Winner and prize fulfilment). Your personal information may be disclosed to a third party as a result of entering this competition, including but not limited to the Sponsor and Ansible.
